
Awning Windows




Sliding Windows






Sliding Doors


Stacker Doors






They are available in two Series: **Comet** - a more budget friendly option, and **Apollo** - a thicker and stronger frame





GLASS & GLAZING



For many years, the effect of glazing on energy performance, home comfort and safety had been greatly under-utilised in Australia.

Poorly designed windows and inefficient glass can make your home too hot or too cold, which increases reliance on artificial heating and air conditioning. Many Australian home owners are unaware of the high performance options available, but carefully chosen glass will help you maintain year round comfort and even reduce your power bills, as well as make your home safe and secure.

Although ensuring compliance with the Building Code of Australia is crucial, there are a few other factors to consider when choosing your glass type. For example - security, noise reduction, maximizing natural light, and lowering energy consumption are all important discussion points to make sure you're making the best possible choice for your home.

The choice in glazing options has grown dramatically in recent years, with some of the more commonly used glass types being:

Float Glass

Float Glass is the common glass that tends to break into large, jagged shards. It is used in some end products - often in double-glazed windows, for example. It is also the starting material that is turned into more advanced products through further processing such as laminating, toughening, coating, etc. Float glass process is renowned for flatness and optical clarity



GLASS & GLAZING



Toughened Glass

Toughened glass is treated to be far more resistant to breakage than simple float glass, and to break in a more predictable way, thus providing a major safety advantage in almost all of its applications. Counteracting stresses give toughened glass its increased mechanical resistance to breakage, and are also - if it does break - what cause it to produce regular, small, typically square fragments rather than long, dangerous shards that are far more likely to lead to injuries. Toughened glass also has an increased resistance to breakage as a result of stresses caused by different temperatures within a pane. Toughened glass has extremely broad applications. Glass portions of building façades, glass sliding doors and partitions in houses and offices, and many other products typically use

toughened glass.

Insulated Glass Units (Double Glazing)

Two or more panels of glass are bonded to a perimeter spacer, either a metal or thermoplastic spacer, (TPS). Either air or argon gas fills the space between the glass panes. Their primary benefit is insulation and solar control. Most types of glass can be incorporated into an insulating glass unit.

Laminated Glass

Laminated glass is made of two or more layers of glass with one or more "interlayers" of polymeric material bonded between the glass layers. Laminated glass offers many advantages. Safety and security are the best known of these - rather than shattering on impact, laminated glass is held together by the interlayer, reducing the safety hazard associated with shattered glass fragments, as well as - to some degree - the security risks associated with easy penetration. Laminated glass is used extensively in building and housing products and in the automotive and transport industries. Most building façades and most car windscreens, for example, are made with laminated glass, usually with other technologies also incorporated.

Low-E Glass (Low Emissive)

Low-E glass has a low rate of emission – that is it has a lower rate than clear float glass of allowing heat to pass through the glass. In other words, if there is a heat source inside your house (or outside), the glass bounces the heat from that object back away from the glass.

Can I put commercial frames in my home?

What are your payment methods?

What colours can I choose from?

There is a virtually endless selection of powder coating colours for you to choose from. At Aluminco, we use the Dulux Powder Coating chart.

Can I take measurements of my own windows and send them through to you?

You definitely can. Please contact us for instructions on how to do so, but please note that the measurements sent through are used for quoting purposes only. We will still need to conduct a site measure if you decide to go ahead with the project, so if there are any variances there may be a slight difference in price.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What does the process usually entail?

Once we receive your enquiry, we will call you to organise your Free Measure and Quote. We endeavour to provide you with a quote within 48 hours, which includes elevation drawings of your windows. If you decide to go ahead with your project, we will send an Invoice for our required 50% deposit. Once the manufacturing process has been completed, we will contact you to book in an installation date. Here we will issue an Invoice for the 40% Progress Payment. Depending on the size and type of project, installation time frames can vary from one day, to several weeks. Once the installation is complete, we conduct a final inspection (preferably with you present), we will remove all rubbish from site if you've selected us to, and forward through an invoice for the Final balance.
